SHIPPING INFORMATION

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C1 Shipping Instructions

1. INTRODUCTION

We are pleased to have this opportunity to service all exhibitors participating in this exhibition. Our comprehensive range of services includes customs clearance, transportation, on-site handling and reexport arrangements handled by our fully-equipped and experienced team of executives, supervisors and workers.

This shipping information will assist you in your preparation for the correct and timely despatch of your exhibits to Thailand. We advise you to read this part of the manual carefully.

The organisers have ruled that no other freight forwarder will be allowed to work on-site or within the exhibition hall other than the appointed Official Freight Forwarders, **ELITE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES LTD. and TRANS-LINK EXPRESS (BANGKOK) CO.,LTD.** They will provide all lifting and handling equipment (such as pallet trucks, forklifts and cranes) on-site for the moving-in of exhibits to the stands or vice versa.

We recommend that you engage the services of our overseas offices and agents worldwide for a complete logistics package for your exhibits 'door to door' from your country to your exhibition stand at **DEFENSE & SECURITY 2007**. If you decide, however, not to use our recommended agents, we ask that you handover this Shipping Manual to your freight forwarder for their compliance so that your exhibits can be correctly despatched and consigned to us. Failure to comply with the deadlines and instructions will cause unnecessary delays in clearance, and may lead to additional expenses being incurred.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Thai Authorities working in line with international conventions, permit exhibits to be imported into Thailand on a 'Temporary Import' basis. To enable us to clear the exhibits under bond on 'Temporary Import' basis, please adhere to all instructions in this Shipping Manual.

3. DOCUMENT DEADLINES

The following documents must be received by us not later than the deadlines shown below or at least 7(seven) days prior to the arrival of the vessel and/or aircraft in Thailand.

10 October 2007 Copies of Bill of Lading and the Commercial Invoice and Packing List for seafreight consignments must be received by us for documentation prior to the arrival of vessel.

17 October 2007 Copies of Commercial Invoice and Packing List for airfreight consignments must be received by us for documentation prior to the arrival of flight.

4. CONSIGNMENT DEADLINES

All exhibition goods must arrive in Bangkok no later than :

17 October 2007	Seafreight consignments.
24 October 2007	Films and video tapes by airfreight.
24 October 2007	Airfreight consignments.

For airfreight consignments, a telex/fax pre-alert must be sent to us indicating the flight numbers, Airway Bill numbers, number of packages, weights and dimensions upon uplift of goods.

Goods arriving after the above deadlines will be subject to a late arrival surcharges (based on the basic handling rate), please refer to our handling tariff.

In any such case, **ELITE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES LTD. / TRANS-LINK EXPRESS (BANGKOK) CO., LTD.** will make all reasonable efforts to ensure delivery before the show opens; however, no guarantees can be given. The surcharge will apply regardless of delivery date to the show site.

5. CONSIGNMENT INSTRUCTIONS

7. DOCUMENTATION

For seafreight consignments, the following documents are required:

2 originals and 3 copies of Bill of Lading
5 copies of Commercial Invoice
5 copies of Packing List
1 copy of Insurance Policy (if insured)

For airfreight consignments, the following documents are required:

2 originals and 3 copies of Airway Bill
5 copies of Commercial Invoice
5 copies of Packing List
1 copy of Insurance Policy (if insured)

To assist you in the preparation of documents, we have attached, at the end of this Shipping Manual, a specially designed Combined Commercial Invoice and Packing List form for your use. You may photocopy additional copies if the attached is insufficient.

Explanatory notes on the filling in of this Combined Commercial Invoice and Packing List form are as follows:

- a. All entries in these forms must be in the English Language.
- b. A full description of the item must be given. Do not just indicate the model name or model number. Describe the item such as "1:3 scale (cutaway) missile model" or "souvenir lapel pins" or "wooden display plinth floor standing", etc.

- c. Every individual item, including giveaway items and brochures, is to be given a value based on CIF value expressed in U.S. dollars. Do not indicate use the phrase "No Commercial Value".
- d. The following declaration must be indicated: "The invoiced goods are of (country)..... origin and are intended for display purposes only at the exhibition site in Bangkok."

The Combined Commercial Invoice and Packing List must be received by us not later than the deadlines shown below or at least 7 (seven) days prior to the arrival of the vessel and/or aircraft in Bangkok:

17 October 2007	Seafreight Consignments
24 October 2007	Airfreight Consignments

For consolidated containerised sea shipments (more than one exhibitor's items in the container), the following additional documents must accompany the Bill of Lading, Commercial Invoice and Packing List:

3 copies of House Bill of Lading
3 copies of Container Manifest

For consolidated air shipments, a House AirwayBill for each exhibitor and a consolidation manifest must be issued.

8. PACKING

Exhibitors are advised to provide strong packing cases for the transportation of the exhibits which can withstand unpacking and repacking operations. For main exhibits, we recommend bolted returnable type cases be used. This is to avoid unnecessary repair and reconstruction of cases in the event of damages due to handling whilst in transit.

9. STORAGE OF EMPTY CASES

Empty cases will be stored within the exhibition site if space is available. Your cases will be marked and stored systematically under shelter during the exhibition period in order to facilitate quick and early retrieval for the repacking at the end of the exhibition.

Note for freight forwarders:

Container detention fee will be levied by shipping lines for containers kept in use for an extended period of time. Free days allowed by shipping lines are usually up to 3 days after the discharge of containers at the port. Should you require us to keep the container within the exhibition site for storage purposes and subsequent re-export, you are to inform us of the container detention fee that has been negotiated with the shipping line.

10. ATA CARNET

Goods can be imported under ATA Carnet. The ATA Carnet is an acceptable document in Thailand for temporary importation of exhibition goods.

11. FILMS & VIDEO TAPES

Any films, video tapes, VCD or DVD to be shown at the exhibition must be cleared by the Board of Film Censors, Thailand.

You are advised to courier these materials "Freight Prepaid" to us by **24 October 2007** to enable us to arrange for censorship clearance.

We would advise you against hand carrying these items into Thailand, as they may be detained by the Thai Customs and considerable time and effort may be required to clear them out in time for the exhibition.

12. FOODSTUFFS/BROCHURES AND GIVEAWAY ITEMS (CONSUMABLES)

A. FOODSTUFF

We do not recommend that you ship foodstuff or beverages to the exhibition and would suggest you buy them in Thailand. If it is essential that you bring your own, please ensure they are packed, documented and shipped on a separate HBL or HAWB from the main exhibits to avoid delays in customs clearance. All foodstuffs and beverages are subject to an Import Licence. Shipment must not be effected until such licence is obtained / approved.

Please note that imported foodstuffs and beverages attract very high duty rates (between 100% and 200%). No exemption will be granted.

DO NOT MIX OR SHIP ALCHOLIC DRINKS OR CANNED FOODSTUFFS WITH YOUR EXHIBITS / STAND MATERIALS AS THESE ITEMS ARE SUBJECT TO STRINGENT INSPECTIONS BY THE THAI CUSTOMS/HEALTH AUTHORITIES.

Failure to comply with this instruction will cause unnecessary delays in clearance, any may lead to additional expenses being incurred.

B. BROCHURES AND GIVEAWAY ITEMS

Brochures and giveaway items/souvenirs are permitted entry into Thailand but some are subject to import duties of between 20% and 80% of the CIF value. These items amongst others are leather wallet, leather key holders, T-shirts, ties, scarves, badges and lapel pins. Such items must be packed and declared separately.

Please note that import duties will be calculated based on declared value or customs assessed value whichever is the greater.

13. COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT

Exhibitors are requested to note that all communication equipment (such as radios, radars, etc) are subject to Import Licence prior to their importation into Bangkok for exhibition purposes.

Exhibitors are to furnish to us the details of the items that you intend to import into Thailand at least 30 days prior to the arrival of the shipment.

14. CUSTOMS EXAMINATION

The Thai Customs are strict and thorough in their examination of goods. All packages can be expected to be opened and contents checked against the Combined Commercial Invoice & Packing List.

HEAVY FINES will be imposed on the exhibitor in cases of '**UNDERVALUATION**', '**NON DECLARATION**' and '**ERRONEOUS DECLARATION**'. In such cases, **ELITE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES LTD. and TRANS-LINK EXPRESS (BANGKOK) CO.,LTD.** shall not be responsible for any delay in clearance. Customs fines and extra expenses incurred shall have to be borne by the exhibitor. Exhibitors are therefore strongly reminded to declare **the true market value** of their goods and be extremely careful in their preparation of documents.

To assist the Thai Customs in their examination, please attach 2 (two) copies of descriptive/ illustrative brochures on the underside of the case lid. If possible, please indicate on these brochures, the model number and serial number of the exhibits.

15. EXHIBIT LAYOUT PLAN

For large or heavy exhibits, an exhibit layout plan is required by us in advance in order to position such exhibits during the early stage of the build-up period.

16. RE EXPORT

All consignments which are imported under temporary importation are required to be exported from Thailand after the exhibition. **Goods are not allowed to be sold/ given away or donated during or after the exhibition.**

Exhibitors are to indicate to us on the Combined Commercial Invoice and Packing List the items that will be reexported as well as the items that will be disposed of, consumed or given away at the end of the exhibition.

We will be circulating a Disposal Instruction Form to you in due course for your completion so that we can plan for the return shipments after the exhibition. Re-export formalities will require at least 7 to 10 days to process before shipments can be sent out.

For goods destined for later exhibitions, our covered storage facility in Bangkok can be utilized at a reasonable storage rate.

17. INSURANCE

As our tariff is computed on the basis of volume or weight and has no correlation with the value of exhibits, it follows that the cost of insurance cover is not included in our charges. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to arrange Marine (Transport) Insurance covering transport to the exhibition, during the exhibition, and the return of the exhibits to domicile, including the period the exhibits are handled by us, and also to ensure that Transport Insurance is arranged for exhibits sold locally. The Insurance shall include a waiver of subrogation against **ELITE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES LTD. and TRANS-LINK EXPRESS (BANGKOK) CO.,LTD.** and/or its agents and/or its sub contractors.

If any exhibit is sold for local delivery, the exhibitor or buyer must arrange Transport Insurance.

18. REQUEST FOR INSURANCE

Upon written instructions, **ELITE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES LTD. / TRANS-LINK EXPRESS (BANGKOK) CO.,LTD.** can offer you insurance coverage at competitive premiums

19. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Inward : Upon uplift of goods, prior to delivery to stand.

Outward : Upon presentation of invoice/prior to delivery to premises.

All payments must be made without any deduction or deferment on account of any claim, counterclaim or off-set. (FOR ELITE ACCOUNT)

C2 Handling Tariff

a. INWARD MOVEMENT (For individual exhibits not exceeding 2,000 kg)

From arrival at Port of Bangkok to exhibition stand inclusive of removal and temporary storage of empty packing cases (where applicable) at site.

Arrival Bangkok Port **US\$150.00** per m³ or 1,000 kg whichever is the greater.
Arrival Leam Chabang Port **US\$180.00** per m³ or 1,000 kg whichever is the greater.

b. OUTWARD MOVEMENT (For individual exhibits not exceeding 2,000 kg)

Same charges will be applied for outgoing services as mentioned above.

Note:

i. The above rates exclude stand dressing, assembly of display panels or machinery or decoration of any kind. If these special services are required, they will be subject to a mutual agreement with the exhibitor and additional charges will be levied.

ii. Port storage charges and removal charges if incurred due to late receipt of negotiable shipping documents will be charged accordingly at cost.

B. AIRFREIGHT CONSIGNMENT

a. INWARD MOVEMENT (For individual exhibits not exceeding 2,000 kg)

From arrival at Bangkok Airport to exhibition stand inclusive of removal and temporary storage of empty packing cases (where applicable) at site.

Basic handling rate **US\$1.50** per kg based on chargeable weight in AWB.

Minimum charge **US\$300.00** per consignment (HAWB) per exhibitor.

Consignment fee **US\$95.00** per consignment (HAWB) per exhibitors.

b. OUTWARD MOVEMENT (For individual exhibits not exceeding 2,000 kg)

Same charges will be applied for outgoing services as mentioned above.

Note:

i. The above rates exclude stand dressing, assembly of display panels or machinery or decoration of any kind. If these special services are required, they will be subject to a mutual agreement with the exhibitor and additional charges will be levied.

ii. Port storage charges and removal charges if incurred due to late receipt of negotiable shipping documents will be charged accordingly at cost.

C. DOCUMENTATION SURCHARGE

All consumable items being packed/shipped together with the exhibition goods in the same consignment will require an extra customs permits for import or export.

Airfreight **US\$100.00** per consignment (HAWB) per exhibitor.

D. IMPORT LICENCE APPLICATION FEE

Application fee **US\$200.00** per application

E. FILMS & VIDEO TAPES

From arrival in Bangkok to exhibition stand excluding the censorship fee levied by the Board of Film Censors.

Handling rate **US\$50.00** per piece

Minimum charge **US\$50.00** per consignment per exhibitor.

F. REPOSITIONING OF EXHIBITS

No charge will be levied for exhibits that require repositioning within the stand.

G. LATE ARRIVAL SURCHARGE

Goods arriving after the deadlines will be subject to 30% late arrival surcharge on our basic handling charges.

Airfreight after **24 October 2007**

H. CRANAGE FOR UNLOADING OR RELOADING OF CONTAINERS AT THE SITE where required.

Load/Empty Container 20ft **US\$100.00** per operation

40ft **US\$200.00** per operation.

I. HEAVY-LIFT SURCHARGES where required.

Our tariffs for seafreight and airfreight consignments are applicable for exhibits not exceeding 2,000 kg per package. Exhibits in excess of 2,000 kg per package will be additionally charged as follows:

WEIGHT PER PACKAGE	HEAVY-LIFT CHARGES
From 2,001 to 3,000 kg	US\$30.00/1000 kgs
From 3,001 to 4,000 kg	US\$40.00/1000 kgs
From 4,001 to 5,000 kg	US\$50.00/1000 kgs.

Exhibits exceeding 5,000 kg per package will be subject to an individual quotation when the dimensions and weights are provided.

These additional heavy lift charges will apply for inward movements as well as for outward movements.

J. TEMPORARY IMPORT BOND FEE

All consignments on "Temporary Importation" into Bangkok will be subject to a bond fee (non-refundable) based on the CIF value of the goods if the goods are not shipped under an ATA Carnet.

Bond fee	1.0% on CIF Value
Minimum charges	US\$200.00 per consignment per exhibitor.

ATA Carnet consignment will be subject to administrative fee **US\$300.00** per consignment per exhibitor.

K. BOND STORAGE CHARGE

At the end of the exhibition, temporary import goods will be required to be moved into the bonded warehouse for storage prior to export to the next destination.

Storage fee **US\$1.00** per m³ per day.

L. VAT (VALUE ADDED TAX) ON HANDLING CHARGES

Our handling charges indicated above do not include VAT. This will be charged at the rate of 7% where applicable.

C3 Special Instructions

A. WEAPONS, AMMUNITION & EXPLOSIVES FOR "STATIC DISPLAY" ONLY

All weapons, ammunition & explosives brought in for the exhibition, must be either "dummy" or "Inert items". Weapons must be made irreversibly inoperable. Missiles and rockets, whether actual size or scale models, must be either a cutaway model or a "dummy" or "inert item." Such items will have to be packed separately and invoices made out separately.

Photographs or brochures with full specifications are required by the Government Authorities before any import permit is given. **Such materials are to be sent to us at least 1 month before the arrival of the exhibits.** Armed security for the storage or the transfer of such exhibits from port or airport to the exhibition site will be arranged by us and billed to you at cost.

B. WEAPONS, AMMUNITION & EXPLOSIVES FOR "LIVE DEMONSTRATION"

Live demonstration of weapons, ammunition & explosives can be arranged for at a designated area under strict control of the Thai Military Authorities. The import of such items, therefore, requires special procedures which must be strictly complied with. Details of such items in the form of technical brochures and photographs indicating full specifications must be sent to us 3 months before the show dates for submission to the Thai Military Authorities for import approval. All such items must be packed and shipped separately and will be under armed security guard whilst in Thailand.
